ric to the plywood with glue which he prefers to use because "it can provide a smoother finish." Use an adhesive that per-

mits the fabric to be removed about and even recessed and reattached if the pattern does not like an accessory, he advised. The black vinyl cloth

covered base used under the box spring is also available at the mattress centers, but those who want to make their own, which will find it simple to do, observed Patisel, assistant to the manager of the furniture design department at Saks.com.

"ALL YOU REALLY need is four pieces of wood nailed together and covered with vinyl. The standard one is about four inches. One would use 2-by-6's available at lumber yards to make the base," he advised. It could be painted if one prefers.

As for the bedboard and shelves, mattress-makers could be taken to a lumber yard where the plywood might be cut to size. If you want out it yourself, use the cutting tools at the lumber yard.

Patisel has successfully glued fabric to upholstery, reupholstered chairs, and prefers it to paint, he ex-

plained. It is an ideal way to decorate beds, but the chest you purchase should be simple, without carvings.

Mission Viejo has started construction on the fourth unit of 46 La Paz Homes, and will shortly feature construction on the fifth unit of 20 Graves Homes.

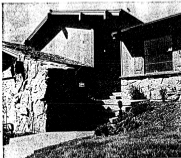
Construction will begin this fall on the third unit of 17 Seville homes.
