Mission Viejo Unveils New Trash Program

Aurora, CO - The Mission Viejo Homeowners' Association Inc. (HOA) has secured a favorable contract with Waste Advantage Company of Denver, Colorado, <http://www.wasteadvantage.com> to provide "single stream recycling" to our residents under a voluntary single-hauler trash program. This program provides homeowners with the opportunity to put their own recyclables together into one container of their choice. Currently in our community we have multiple trash companies on our streets, picking up trash on different days of the week. Garbage trucks can be seen in our community seven days a week. There is a lot of wear and tear on our streets and there is absolutely no benefit to our community. This program aims at setting up a single trash company to be on our streets one day a week and to create a mutually beneficial partnership. A very small portion (\$2 a month) of each residential trash fee will help support the Mission Viejo HOA and will be considered a benefit of HOA membership. This money will be used to enable such things as neighborhood events, community clean-up efforts, entranceway improvements, and a monthly newsletter among other projects.
